Canal: Nelsen looking at a new chemical possibly for weed spraying in the canal. Change chemicals periodically is necessary so the weeds don't develop resistance. The Board verbally agreed to hire an aquatic weed contractor to assist this year.

Parks: The picnic shelter concrete slab may be poured in April weather permitting. Superior Concrete will do the work. Once that is complete the sprinkler system will need re-routed or replaced in many areas. Cullen Deis will be contacted for a bid once the concrete is completed. A shade cover over the new concrete slab was discussed. A strong fabric cover would be a flexible option so footing placement could be accomplished outside of the slab. Nelsen will get some pictures and share with the board. One of the Gym shade covers needs replaced as the perpetual winds in the Spring of 2022 damaged it beyond repair.

Park mowing bids were obtained and Jason Hanson was selected based on price and services he will provide. Marso would like us to keep him in mind for bidding next year.
